What is the TRIAD Friendly Visitors Program?

The mission of the Triad Friendly Visitors Program is to match a senior volunteer and a reserve officer with an interested senior who would benefit from social interaction and resource information.

How Do I Become a Friendly Visitor?

The first step is to call the Friendly Visitors Coordinator at 349-3854 ext. 2900 and request an application. Once completed and returned, you'll be scheduled for a brief interview.

How can I help and what would my responsibilities be?

You can brighten the life of a senior citizen by becoming a Friendly Visitor. As a volunteer, you would be matched with a reserve officer and a senior citizen who would benefit from your friendship.

Typically, Friendly Visitors stop by the home of a senior weekly. While there, they check on the safety and comfort of the senior and have a little visit, talk, and share subjects of interest.
